Proverbs 1–9



- Get all the knowledge, wisdom, and understanding you possibly can, because that's the key to preventing this sin.
 - Proverbs 2:10–16; 6:20–24; 7:1–5.
 - Proverbs 6:32; 9:13–18.



- Don't play around with this sin. Get as far away as possible; take every precaution.
 - Proverbs 5:7–8; 7:24–26.
 - Great example: Joseph (Genesis 39:7–12).
 - Romans 13:13–14.



- Don't be taken in by smooth, flattering, or enticing speech.
 - Proverbs 2:16; 5:3; 6:24; 7:5, 21.
 - Proverbs 9:16–17.



- Sexual immorality carries with it some very serious consequences.
 - Proverbs 2:18–19; 5:3–6; 6:25–29, 32–35.
 - Proverbs 5:12–14.



- Remember, this sin cannot hidden from God.
 - Proverbs 5:20–21.
 - Proverbs 2:17: "who has left the partner of her youth and ignored the covenant made before God" (NIV).



- There's only one place where sexual desires should be fulfilled—in the marriage relationship.
 - Proverbs 5:15–20.
 - Hebrews 13:4.
