The Man Approved by God

"Be diligent ("do your best"—ESV) to present yourself **approved to God**, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing ("accurately handling"—NAS) the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).

- He is **not**...
 - The man who has never sinned.
 - Rom. 3:23; 1 John 1:8, 10.
 - The man who commends/approves himself.
 - 2 Cor. 10:18; Luke 18:9-14.
 - The man approved by others.
 - 1 Samuel 16:7; Luke 16:15.

- The man who works at it.
 - "...a WORKER who does not need to be ashamed..."
 - Christians often described in N.T. as "workers" or "laborers"
 - **2** Tim. 2:21; 3:17.
 - "Be **steadfast**, **immovable**, **always abounding** in the work of the Lord..." (1 Cor. 15:58).

- The man who is diligent.
 - "Be DILIGENT..." (Gr., "to use speed")
 - Suggests urgency and effort.
 - Many commands prefaced by "be diligent...", or "give diligence."
 - Heb. 4:11; 11:6.

- The man who "rightly divides" or "handles accurately" the word of truth.
 - Greek means literally "to cut straight."
 - B.W. Johnson: "...present the truth clearly, truthfully, without blunders, with an exactness that cannot be gainsaid."
 - Surrounding verses (14-18) indicate importance of this.

- The man who "rightly divides" or "handles accurately" the word of truth.
 - Proper manner is important, too.
 - Can be too soft (2 Tim. 4:2).
 - Can also be too harsh (2 Tim. 2:24-26).
 - □ Important words of caution in 2 Peter 3:16.

- The man who approves of God's ways.
 - Philippians 1:9-11; Rom. 1:32.
 - You can't be approved by God...
 - If you approve homosexuality.
 - If you approve adulterous marriages.
 - If you approve of denominationalism.
 - If you approve different conditions of pardon.

- The man who works at it.
- The man who is diligent.
- The man who rightly divides or handles accurately the word of God—in content and attitude.
- The man who approves of God's ways.
