

2 Timothy 4



Preach Sound Doctrine

Timothy's Duties

- “Preach the word! Be ready in season, out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and teaching” (v. 2).
- “But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry” (v. 5).

Incentives Given to Timothy

- “I charge you before God and the Lord Jesus Christ...” (v. 1).
- “who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing...” (v. 1).
- “For the time will come when men will not endure sound doctrine” (vv. 3-4).

Incentives Given to Timothy

- “The time of my departure is at hand” (v. 6).
- “There is laid up for me the crown of righteousness” (v. 8).
- “Demas has forsaken me...” (v. 9). “Mark...is useful to me for ministry” (v. 11). “Alexander...did me much harm...greatly resisted our words” (15).
- “But the Lord stood with me and strengthened me...” (v. 17).
